**BANGALORE:** The Shobana Jeyasingh Dance Company, from the United Kingdom, will perform in Bangalore on November 8 as part of its maiden tour of India.

According to a statement from the British Council, which is supporting the tour along with The Arts Council English, the Bangalore performance is at the Chowdiah Memorial Hall, Vyalikaval, at 7.30 p.m. and will feature two of Shobana's most imaginative and inventive dance works, *Faultline* and *Bruise Blood*.

Shobana's work is rooted in her experiences as a British Asian and explores the conflicts between diverse personal and cultural origins.

Her choreography draws upon various sources, including ballet, Bharatanatyam and contemporary ethnic dance forms.
